LGBTQ community members reach to us for help and special prayer during these desperate times. We hope one day soon we will be able to win their souls for Jesus. This is challenging for us to work more openly while sharing the Gospel making it harder with Lockdown but we are praying that we will be able to healing prayer seminar for these community members soon after lockdown is lifted as we keep getting calls for special prayers from them.





We believe God will continue to use us as his instrument to speak and give us divine wisdom to keep reaching out to these communities not only with acts of service and charity but with the bringing them to accept Jesus as their personal saviour.





We reached 100 marginalized families in Rungamuttee Gram Panchayat, Malbazar block battling hunger due to the second wave of COVID-19 providing them with groceries & surgical face mask.

We extend our gratitude and pray blessings over some of our local friend's one of our friend who is a gospel singer Daniel Gadal of Den Music studios team who contributed towards reaching 24 community members.



Both Benjamin & Swapna joined us for the Community Relief who prayed for us as a team before the distribution and also for the people gathered for the relief.

“ I was working as a daily wage labourers in the tea plantation factory but due to the lockdown I have no means of livelihood so I and my family had to beg on the streets to afford a onetime meal. 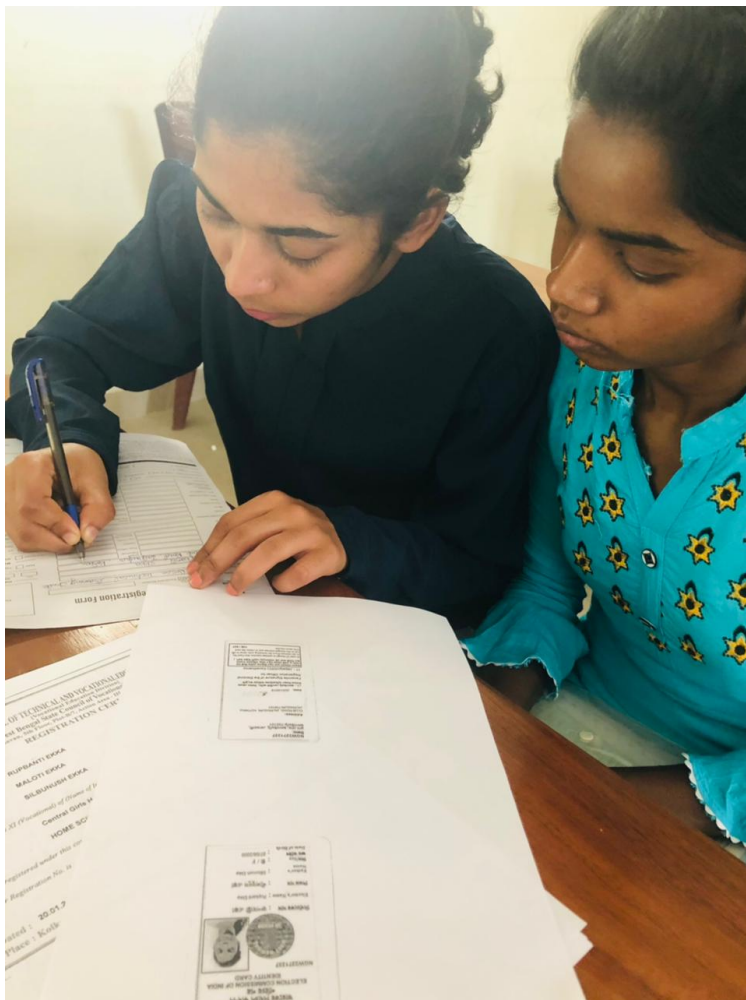
Everyday we step out we sensed the gentle hands of protection of Jesus over our lives
